2. General Manager to provide a brief update to the board on District Business (including but not limited to):
  - Bright Night solar plant's request to cross the north end of the Dam with 230kV powerline.
    - i. MFCD has provided review comments on the proposed crossing.
  - SCIDD's desire to terminate the Northside Canal at the intersection with Lower Magma Channel.
    - i. SCIDD has prepared 90% plans; MFCD's engineer is currently reviewing the plans.
  - Update on the Middle Magma Regional Flood Control Project
    - i. Funding:
      - a) NRCS is processing an \$80k+/- grant for additional planning funds for the project.

  - ii. Funding (continued):
    - a) NRCS intends to fund the remaining project design costs 100%;
    - b) NRCS intends to fund construction cost 100% (once formal grant is approved & design is final)
    - c) Local Sponsors (Pinal County & MFCD in a 50/50 split) are responsible for all land rights and permitting costs (MFCD will update the IGA with Pinal County to address these topics)
      - a. Pinal County land department is leading efforts to begin title work and appraisal process to clarify and perfect drainage easement rights within Wild Horse Estates.
  - iii. Phase 1: Environmental Assessments & Planning (ongoing thru end of 2022)
    - a) Continuing to address comments on Plan/EA received from NWMC in late June 2022.
    - b) Aim to submit a Final Plan/EA to NRCS for approval in late Nov. 2022.
  - iv. Phase 2: Final Design & Construction Plans (90% design will begin upon final approval of Plan/EA; 100% design is anticipated during Summer of 2023; Construction estimated to begin late 2023)
