- 2. General Manager to provide a brief update to the board on District Business (including but not limited to):
  - The District continues working with AZ State Land Dept (as well as AZG&F, Pinal County Sheriff's office, AZ State Parks, local ranchers, and other stakeholders) to address the OHV use violations on District property and concerns within the surrounding areas. ASLD anticipates taking formal action to close the area to OHVs during the Spring of 2024.
  - SCIDD's desire to terminate the Northside Canal at the intersection with Lower Magma Channel.
    - i. MFCD's engineer has reviewed and approved SCIDD's 100% plans;
    - ii. MFCD & SCIDD working to finalize project agreements.
  - The Middle Magma Regional Flood Control Project
    - i. The Watershed Plan (Plan), Environmental Assessment (EA), & Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) have all been approved and signed by NRCS AZ.
  - ii. Plan/EA now goes to NRCS National Office for approval & authorization of design funding. Note: Everything below this point is based upon the <u>assumption</u> that the Final Plan/EA and any related funding grants that are required are approved and authorized.
    - iii. Funding:
      - a) NRCS will fund the remaining project design costs 100%;
      - b) NRCS intends to fund construction cost 100% (assuming both final design & formal grant application is approved)
      - c) Local Sponsors (Pinal County & MFCD in a 50/50 split) are responsible for all land rights and permitting costs (MFCD will update the IGA with Pinal County to address these topics)
        - a. Pinal County land department is leading efforts to begin title work and appraisal process to clarify and perfect drainage easement rights within Wild Horse Estates.
    - iv. Phase 1: Planning—Final Plan/EA approval—likely ongoing thru 3/31/24.
    - v. Phase 2A: Design & Construction Plans—NRCS approval of 90% design: goal date 6/1/24.
    - vi. Phase 2B: Construction—estimated to begin 12/1/24; estimated completion 10/15/25.
- 3. Ratification of the December 6, 2023 action of the Pinal County Board of Supervisors to appoint Terrel Brad Hinton "Brad" to the Board of the Magma Flood Control District for a term of four years. Brad has provided a signed and notarized oath of office statement.
